

## NEDO Japanese-German Co-Funding Program

### Aim of Programme

---

▶ The New Energy and Industrial Technology Development Organization (NEDO) is one of the largest public research and development management organizations in Japan. The Co-Funding Program aims to promote innovation in technological development through collaborative efforts in R&D projects with the German partners. The partnership should complement each other and demonstrate an added value to the project.

### Funding Conditions

---

- ▶ 1. Funding will be provided in the form of a conditional grant to the projects selected under the Call for Proposals.
- ▶ 2. The total funding from NEDO will not exceed 50 % (66.6 % for SMEs and R&D partnerships) of the eligible and approved costs of the R&D activities.
- ▶ 3. When a project results in sales of a product, service or process, all or part of the financial support must be repaid to NEDO for 5 years after the completion of the joint R&D in accordance with the applicable regulations. If the project does not result in sales, no repayment is required.

### Requirements

---

- ▶ The joint partner has to be a German consortium as the Co-Funding Program is created by a joint statement among METI, NEDO and BMWi concluded in March 2017.
